
Sliding doors to be installed inside the wall must be planned well in advance because it is very difficult to incorporate them into a house once it has been built. This is because the running rails must run inside the wall.

You should also bear in mind that a sliding door inside the wall and including handle bar will also slightly reduce the width of the passage way because the leaf will remain in the opening when it is open. A door leaf with retractable pull ring can be slid into the wall completely.

Fire protection

Fire protection doors prevent the spread of fires, stabilise burning buildings and allow people and valuables to be saved.



Smoke protection

Smoke protection doors protect people from the life-threatening effects of smoke. During a fire they prevent agonising choking caused by the depletion of oxygen.



Burglar-resistant doors

Burglar resistant doors can withstand attempted break-ins using physical force for longer periods of time. They protect material and intellectual property against theft and robbery.

The surface is the visible outer side of the door leaf and is made of wood veneer veneer, CPL, lacquer or glass.

Wooden frame

This is the fixed part of a door element, into which the moving part, the door leaf, fits. It is also used as the base for the hinges which connect the door leaf to the frame.

Sidelight/Top light

Storey-high doors go up to the ceiling. Elements with sidelight or top light complete the frames. You can find more information about these on pages 120-121.

Door closers

Our door closers automatically close our wing doors in a controlled manner after they have been opened.

Hinges

The hinges connect the door frame to the door.

These are used to allow the door to swing and for installing and removing the door – see pages 122-123.

Ventilation grilles

Our ventilation grilles are used for the ventilation of and extraction of air from rooms, which, for example, do not have their own windows or ventilation systems or which have high levels of air humidity.

11

Drop seal

To prevent the unhindered travel of sound waves and air currents between the floor and the door, we recommend the use of our integrated drop seal.

Spy hole

You can prevent the entry of unwanted visitors into your rooms using our spy. Using our spy hole, you can see who is at the door without having to open it.

13

Handle

The handle is one of the basic design components of the door. The design of the handle should harmonise with the style of the door set and with the hinges.



Frames

Full-flush and flush-optic

The frame surrounds the door and is firmly attached to the wall surrounding the door. It is used to secure the door leaf in place. This is performed using the hinges attached to the frame and to the door leaf. Frames are available in a wide range of visual and functional designs. According to the combination of frame and door leaf used, doors can be described as being either "full-flush" or "flush-optic" doors.

Full-flush doors

In full-flush doors, the door leaf and the frame are flush with the adjacent areas. These are particularly effective in very modern rooms.



Flush – The door leaf is flush and in its external appearance it is on the same level as the sealing level.

Flush-optic doors

The door leaf is rebated. Seen from the opening side, however, it looks like a full-flush door. From the closing side, you can see a shadow gap running around it. A normal frame can be used for this model.



Flush-optic – The door leaf is rebated and closes flush with the frame.

Important note

In full-flush and flush-optic door sets, the door surface does not close completely flush with the architrave of the door frame.


